The János Bak Award was established in honor of Professor János M. Bak (1929-2020), co-founder of the Department of Medieval Studies at CEU (now Historical Studies). It offers 2000 EUR to support study in one of the medieval tracks in Historical Studies at CEU. The award is open to students with a particular interest in the medieval and early-modern history of Central, East-Central and Eastern Europe.

Awards have previously been given to projects on Lotharingia and medieval Hungary, the Ottoman Pashas of Buda, and art in the Hungarian Illuminated Chronicle.

To apply for the Award, submit an application to the Late Antique and Medieval Track of either:

- ✱ The research-oriented one-year MA in Historical studies. This program is tailored to students who have already identified a research area about which they are passionate.
- ✱ The two-year MA in Historical Studies. This program provides a systematic introduction to theories, methods and research skills in a variety of historical disciplines.

- ✱ A letter (up to 300 words) explaining the applicant's interest in the history of medieval Central, East-Central and Eastern Europe.
- ✱ A short CV.
